



## PhD in Precision Nutrition Part of the Marie Skłodowska-Curie Action (MSCA) project NUTRIOME

The UCD Nutrition, Biomarkers and Health Research group are seeking a PhD candidate to join an exciting new project called NUTRIOME funded under the Marie Skłodowska-Curie Action (MSCA) programme.

*NUTRIOME - Precision nutrition and postprandial immune responses* is a [MSCA Doctoral Network](#). The NUTRIOME network involves academic partners at nine European academic institutions and six associated partners from industry across Norway, Poland, The Netherlands, Germany, Denmark, Finland, Sweden, Ireland, and the United Kingdom. The purpose of the NUTRIOME network is to train 10 RDCs in data-driven precision nutrition through human intervention studies, omics-technologies and advanced data analyses, in order to evaluate personal responses to foods and diets. ### **The EU provides support for each recruited researcher in the form of:**

- a living allowance
- a mobility allowance
- if applicable, family, long-term leave and special needs allowances

### **Required qualifications:**

- must not have a doctoral degree at the date of their recruitment
- can be of any nationality
- excellent communication skills in both spoken and written English
- should be enrolled in a doctoral programme during the project
- should comply with the mobility rules: in general, they must not have resided or carried out their main activity (work, studies, etc.) in the country of the recruiting organisation for more than 12 months in the 36 months immediately before their recruitment date

### **Expected qualifications:**

- excellence of educational degree
- specialization and additional knowledge
- quality of previous research studies and reports
- authorship in scientific publications
- analytical skills and motivation and attitude toward carrying out the individual training/mobility project

### **Recruitment procedure**

A prioritized shortlist of the top five candidates for each position will be distributed among partners in NUTRIOME. Then the partners will agree upon which candidates to invite for an interview, which will take place via zoom at each of the host institutions. A candidate may be transferred to another project depending on their qualification.
